What does an Attendance Mentor do?

- Promote regular, on-time attendance
- Be a consistent, positive role model who helps mentee with goal setting and problem solving skills

Why Does Attendance Matter?

Research shows that good attendance, missing no more than 10% of school, increases a child's success in social and academic domains of school and increases the likelihood of graduation from high school.

Why Mentors?

Last year in Billings, students with an attendance mentor went from missing 16% of school to only missing 9%.
