Why Does Attendance Matter?

Research shows that good attendance, missing no more than 10% of school, increases a child's success in social and academic domains of school and increases the likelihood of graduation from high school.

Why Mentors?

Last year in Billings, students with a Success Mentor went from missing 16% of school to only missing 9%.
