Who: Anyone of any age can participate

(An adult must accompany children under 14)

What: Drill to simulate a public health emergency

When: Thursday, April 17, 2014. Come any time between 1 and 3 pm.

(Your participation should take less than 20 minutes.)

Why: At RiverStone Health, our job as a public health agency means we must prepare for catastrophic public health

events such as disease outbreaks, bio-terrorist attacks

and natural disasters.

In an emergency, we may need to quickly provide medicine to everyone in Yellowstone and Carbon counties, using medical supplies from the Strategic National Stockpile (SNS). People would receive the medicine at local Points of Dispensing (PODS).

You can help us test -- on a small scale -- our ability to rapidly dispense SNS medication. Volunteers will fill out medical forms, answer a few questions, and receive the mock medication.

Each participant will walk away with added knowledge, a small gift and a chance to win a grand prize.
