1. American Fact Finder

As part of its Needs Assessment for the Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting Infrastructure Development Project, the Best Beginnings Council of Yellowstone County has identified thirteen "neighborhoods" that consist of one or more Tracts used for the 2010 Census. By recognizing areas of the County that are familiar to residents and program providers, the Council is attempting to encourage greater participation in the needs assessment process (Census Tract geography is not commonly understood by many data users whereas people in the community are familiar with the neighborhoods identified herein). The thirteen neighborhoods and the Census Tracts included in each are listed in the table on the next page. Maps showing each neighborhood, along with the applicable data spreadsheet, are included in Appendix A.

In addition to the maps referenced above, a map showing the general location of 2010 Census Tracts within Yellowstone County is included on page 19 of this Part, followed by a table listing the data categories selected for this analysis, along with the statistics for the County. Using the American Fact Finder and American Community Survey research tools, data for each Census tract was gathered and if the neighborhood consists of more than one tract, the data was aggregated when possible. The results of this data analysis are included in Appendix A.


¹ Poverty data for families with related children under age 5, for female households with related children under age 18, and for female households with related children under age 5 is available for each Census Tract but cannot be aggregated on a neighborhood basis due to statistical limitations. However, poverty data for all families and for families with related children under age has been calculated for each of the thirteen neighborhoods.

The primary purpose of identifying neighborhoods that are commonly recognized and then compiling data from the 2010 Census into totals for each of these areas is to enable the Best Beginnings Council of Yellowstone County to make meaningful comparisons and determine areas of needs on a geographic basis that is recognizable to users of the Council's Needs Assessment. Complete Census Tract data has been included to allow users of this Needs Assessment to narrow the geographic scope of their research if so desired. As noted in footnote 7, more complete poverty data is available at the Census Tract level.
