## **Using this Directory**

#### **Definitions**

**CENTER child care:** A center serves thirteen or more children with a staff-to-child ratio based on the age of the children. State law requires child care Centers to be licensed by the State of Montana's Child Care Licensing Program.

**FAMILY child care:** One caregiver caring for up to six children at a time with no more than three under the age of two years. Care is offered in a home-like setting, usually in the caregiver's residence. Family child cares must be registered with the State of Montana's Child Care Licensing Program.

**GROUP child care:** Two caregivers providing care for seven to twelve children, with a limit of six under the age of two years. Care is offered in a home-like setting, usually in one of the caregiver's residences. Group childcares must be registered with the State of Montana's Child Care Licensing Program.

**STARS to Quality:** a voluntary quality rating and improvement system that aligns quality indicators with support and incentives for early childhood programs and early childhood professionals.

**CACFP:** Child and Adult Food Care Program--a federal program that provides reimbursements for nutritious meals and snacks to eligible children and adults who are enrolled for care at participating child care centers, day care homes, and adult day care centers.

**Unlicensed/Unregistered Childcares:** Before school, drop-in, after school, and preschool programs are NOT required to be licensed or registered with the State of Montana's Child Care Licensing Program and are not monitored or inspected.

## How to Select the Right Care for your Child

The Montana Department of Health and Human Services provides the following tips when searching for a safe, high quality learning environment for your child.

#### **LEARNING**

- Are the play spaces organized with age-appropriate toys and books, puzzles and blocks easy to reach and use?
- Does the child care program offer both structured and unstructured play time daily?
- Do providers frequently read and sing to children throughout the day?
- Does the child care program allow screen time? National guidelines recommend children less than 2 years old have no screen time. For children 2 years and over the total screen time is less than thirty minutes each week, for educational or physical activity use only. This includes home and child care settings.

#### PROGRAM ENRICHMENT

- Does the child care program participate in Montana's Best Beginnings STARS to Quality?
- Is the program accredited by a national organization? Accreditation indicates the program has been recognized by a leading national organization for providing excellent care.
- Does the program participate in the Federal food program (Child and Adult Care Food Program)?

#### **SUPERVISION**

- Are children supervised at all times, including when they are sleeping?
- Are teachers warm, welcoming and interacting with each child?
- Are clear and simple safety rules established with the children?
- Do teachers focus on positive, clear, consistent and fair guidance?
- Are there enough staff-members to supervise all children? See the ratios below.

#### **RATIOS**

#### **Child Care Center**

Birth to 23 months: 1 adult to 4 children 2 Yrs-3 Yrs: 1 adult to 8 children 4 Yrs-5 Yrs: 1 adult to 10 children 6 Yrs and over: 1 adult to 14 children

# Family Child Care 1 adult: 6 children

No more than 3 children can be under the age of 2; 6 children maximum

# Group Child Care 1 adult: 6 children

No more than 6 children can be under the age of 2; 12 children maximum

#### **HEALTH & SAFETY**

- Do teachers follow standards for health and safety, including proper hand washing, diapering, and toileting?
- Is someone always present who has current pediatric (infant/child) CPR and pediatric first aid training?
- Is there a plan for responding to disasters (fire, food, etc.)?
- Do the children go outside every day unless the weather or conditions don't support outdoor time?
- · Is the playground regularly inspected for safety?
- · Does the child care program support breastfeeding?
- · Are infants held by adults during feeding?
- · Does the child care program serve meals?

#### PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Do the teachers and director have a credential or an early childhood-related degree?
- Have the Director and teacher(s) had specific training on children's development and experience caring for children?
- Do the directors and teachers receive early childhood-related training or education?

#### COMMUNICATION

- Are parents always welcome in the home or center and given a copy of the program's policies?
- · Are annual conferences or regular and consistent communication held with parents?

## **Best Beginnings Child Care Scholarship Program**

#### From the Montana Department of Health and Human Services Child Care Website:

The Early Childhood Services Bureau in Montana offers Best Beginnings child care scholarships to qualified low-income families whose child receives care from a licensed child care center, licensed group or family child care home, or Family, Friend, and Neighbor (FFN) child care provider.

Each family participates in the cost of that care by making a copayment based on a sliding fee scale. Scholarships are available to working families whose income is at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines and families who get cash assistance through the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program. The program helps to pay for care when parents are not available to care for their children:

- · During working hours
- During school or training hours, if meeting work requirements
- If they are a teen parent attending high school;
- If they are a parent receiving TANF who is participating in family investment agreement activities.


